By submitting these documents to International Student Services, you are attesting to the availability of financial resources to fully support your education at Pepperdine. *Knowingly providing documents that are not genuine, accurate or representative of your financial means and resources may lead to serious immigration consequences, including a finding of visa fraud and/or termination of your ability to enter or remain in the US as an F-1 student.*

**INSTRUCTIONS:** For students applying for a Form I-20 (for F-1 status) from Pepperdine University. Complete and attach this form to your financial documents **ONLY** in the following situations: (1) you are receiving funding from a parent, relative, or other private individual other than yourself; and/or (2) you are receiving a scholarship or fellowship from an organization other than Pepperdine University. You do **NOT** need to submit this form if your funding sources are from your own personal funds (e.g., personal bank statement) and/or from a Pepperdine University scholarship.

**Applicants Receiving Funding from Home Country Government, Employer, or Other Organizations**

If you will receive a scholarship, fellowship, financial aid award, grant, or other financial assistance from an organization other than Pepperdine University, list the scholarship and the type of organization. Examples include: Home or US government scholarship, home university scholarship, home country employer, international organization, other private foundation or organization.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Students should be prepared to demonstrate personal or family financial documentation if applying for a scholarship/sponsorship if the exact scholarship details are not yet guaranteed. Understandably sponsors want to be sure they are only funding the exact costs and will not officially guarantee/confirm until students provide their actual expenses (i.e. courses after add/drop period, housing plan, etc). This delay directly conflicts with the time necessary for students to obtain the Form 120. Therefore, unless the scholarship or sponsorship is already fully secured and deemed sufficient for I20 issuance by Pepperdine, students should be prepared to submit other acceptable forms of financial evidence by the deadlines..
