THE NEW BIOLOGY: WHAT DO ESTATE PLANNERS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT ASSISTED REPRODUCTION

The widespread use of assisted reproduction technologies, including gestational carriers, donated eggs and sperm, and the ability to freeze genetic material or even harvest it after a person's death, presents multiple challenges to estate planners, from the drafting stage to the administration of an estate. Professor Knaplund will discuss what you need to know about assisted reproduction and estate planning.

Professor Kristine S. Knaplund began her career in law teaching in 1983 at UCLA Law School, where she was honored with the law school's Rutter Award for Excellence in Teaching in 1991, the University-wide Harriet and Charles Luckman Distinguished Teaching Award in 1995, and the 1997 graduating class' Professor of the Year Award. She joined the faculty of Pepperdine University School of Law in 2002, and teaches Property, Wills and Trusts, Advanced Wills and Trusts, and the Bioethics Seminar. In 2006 she received the 1L Professor of the Year Award, and in 2008 she received the University's Howard White Award for Excellence in Teaching.
