All winners (first, second, and third places in each category) will receive a full year's subscription to *Image: A Journal of Arts and Religion*, a one-year membership in the Conference on Christianity and Literature, and publication of their work on the CCL website.

The contest is open to all regularly enrolled undergraduates.

**Final Judges:** James Zoller (Poetry), Linda Buturian (Non-Fiction), and Tom Noyes (Fiction)

Although submissions need not address religious experience directly, each entry should suggest its writer's vision of spiritual inquiry. Students may submit up to three typed entries (font size 12-14). Poems should be no more than two pages long; fiction and non-fiction entries must be double-spaced and may not exceed fifteen pages.

Only the title of the work should appear on each entry. A separate page for each work should list:

Author's name  
E-mail address  
Permanent mailing address  
Current academic affiliation  
Category of each entry  
Title(s) of work(s) entered
