

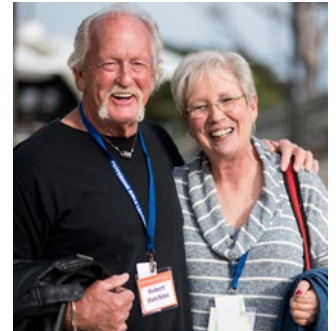

PETE PETERSON NAMED DEAN OF PEPPERDINE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF PUBLIC POLICY



On March 17 it was announced that Pete Peterson has been named the dean of the School of Public Policy (SPP). Peterson has served SPP in many capacities over the course of his nearly decadelong career at Pepperdine, most recently in the role of interim dean, a title he has held since September 2015. He has led the Davenport Institute for Public Engagement and Civic Leadership as executive director since 2010 and has held various teaching roles at Pepperdine since 2007.

"Pete Peterson is a proven leader who will lead the School of Public Policy with a strong sense of mission and with confidence into the future," says Pepperdine University president Andrew K. Benton.

Peterson earned his bachelor of arts in history from The George Washington University, and he completed his master of public policy from the Pepperdine University School of Public Policy. He currently resides in Santa Monica, California. Peterson assumed his responsibilities as dean immediately.
