PEPPERDINE CAMPUS ENHANCEMENTS COMING SOON!



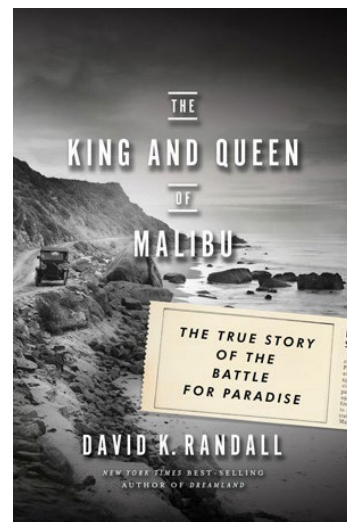

In 2017 we will begin a significant remodel at the School of Law: we will upgrade the Henry J. and Gloria Caruso Auditorium into a modernly appointed, divisible classroom, complete with state-of-the-art learning technology, and modernize the Lon V. Smith Atrium into a hub for interaction, activity, and student use. Also in 2017, we will break ground on a new student residence hall, offering suite-style living with desirable student common spaces.
