




Each academic year, the Office of Institutional Effectiveness (OIE) surveys Pepperdine alumni from a Seaver College division. Over the past two academic years, 1,949 alumni from the Natural Science, Humanities and Teacher Education, and Communication divisions were surveyed. These alumni reported the following:

**METRICS**

- ◆ Primary activity: “What is your current primary activity?” In addition to the results presented, approximately 7% of participants indicated “not employed by choice,” and 2% indicated “not employed, but seeking” as their primary activity.
- ◆ Recommend: “Would you recommend Pepperdine to others?” Ratings based on a four-point scale, with 1 = *definitely no* to 4 = *definitely yes*.
- ◆ Re-enroll: “If given the choice again, would you re-enroll at Pepperdine?” Ratings based on a four-point scale, with 1 = *definitely no* to 4 = *definitely yes*.
- ◆ First job: “After graduating from Pepperdine, how long did it take to secure your first job/employment?”
- ◆ Overall college experience: “Please rate your satisfaction with Pepperdine on the following items.” Ratings were based on a five-point scale, with 1 = *very dissatisfied* to 5 = *very satisfied*.
- ◆ Development: “To what extent did the following contribute to your personal and professional development?”
