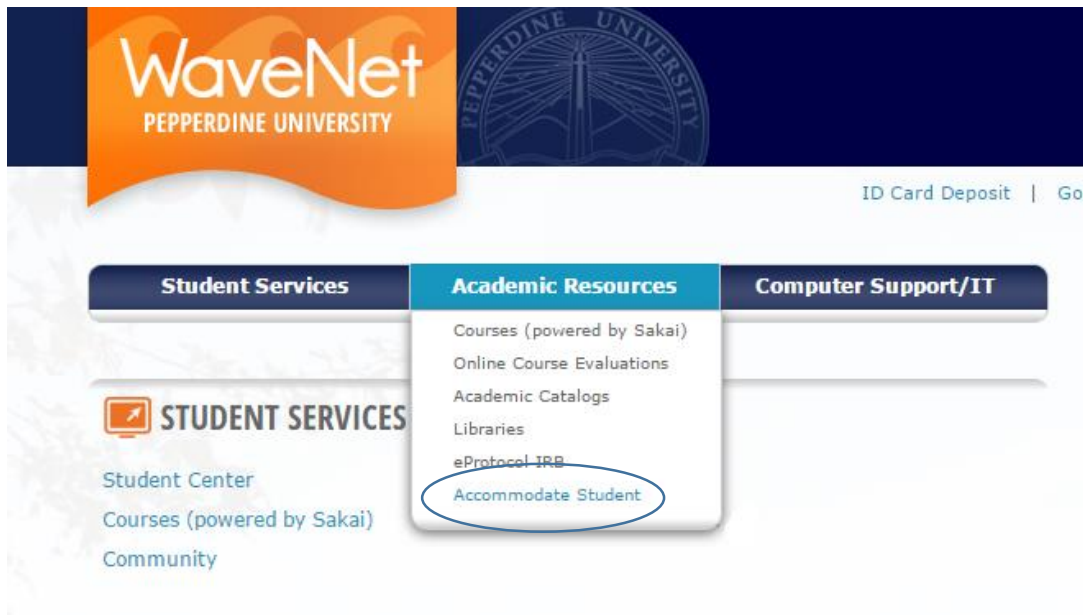


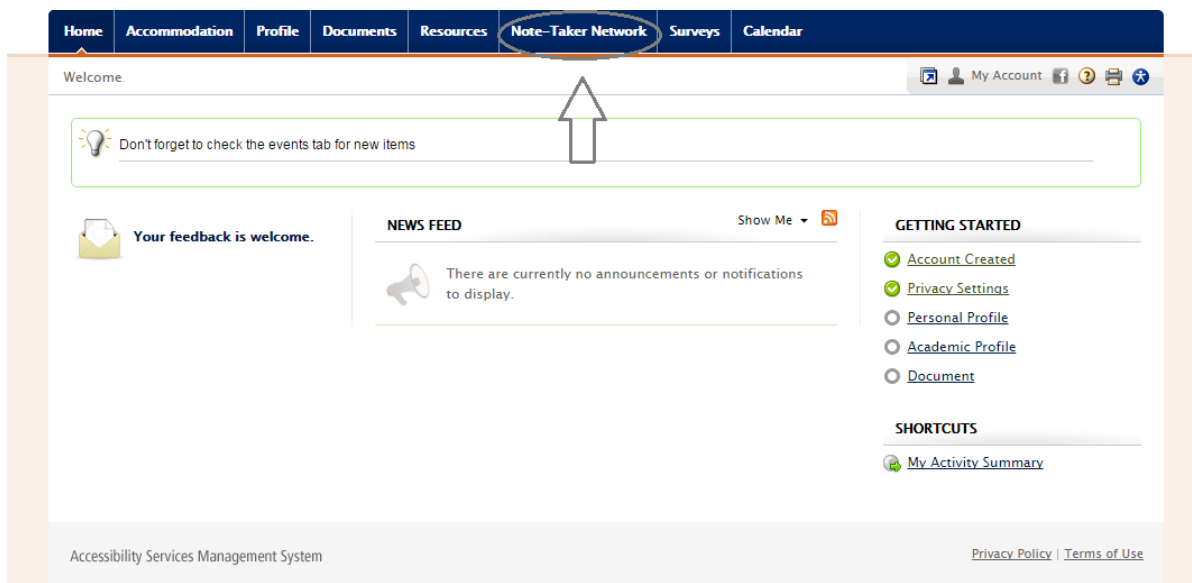
## How to Access your Notes on Accommodate

\*Please note that you will not be able to access notes unless you have completed a Semester Request and a note taker has been hired for your class.

1. Log in on Wavenet
2. Navigate to Academic Resources tab > Accommodate Student
  - a. **\*Please be mindful of pop-up blockers and web browsers. Some browsers may not be compatible with the Accommodate system.**



3. You will see your Accommodations Home Page
  - a. Navigate to the Note-Taker Network tab



4. Your Note Taker page will have a library of notes that have been submitted for your classes
